Sacramento - The California Air Resource Board (CARB) announced on January 26, 2018 that it has certified a new biodiesel additive, California Fueling, LLC's VESTA™ 5000, per Executive Order G-714-ADF03, entitled "Certification of Alternate Diesel Fuel Resulting in Emissions Equivalence with Diesel".¹ VESTA™ 5000 is heretofore approved for use in biodiesel blends above the seasonal allowance up to and including B20.
