CALIFORNIA FUELING, LLC GRANTED CARB APPROVAL OF VESTA™ 5100

Sacramento - The California Air Resource Board (CARB) announced on June 7, 2018 that it has certified a new biodiesel additive, California Fueling, LLC's VESTA™ 5100, per Executive Order G-714-ADF07, entitled "Certification of Alternate Diesel Fuel Resulting in Emissions Equivalence with Diesel".¹ VESTA™ 5100 is heretofore approved for use in biodiesel blends above the seasonal allowance up to and including B20. California Fueling, LLC is a privately-owned business focused on emission reduction strategies associated with California's Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS). The company's primary focus is to provide the fuel community with enabling technologies, specifically NOX Mitigants, aimed at meeting CARB's Alternate Diesel Fuel Regulation.

California Fueling, LLC's President, Yvette McDuff, commented that "our single objective in developing VESTA™ 5100 was to improve our economic offering. By reducing our treat rate >30%, versus VESTA™ 5000, we hope to further encourage B20 use in the marketplace. With LCFS credits in the vicinity of \$170, the incremental cost of adding VESTA™ 5100 has significantly improved. We are clearly seeing an uptick in B20 volumes in Q2 and we hope that trend will continue as California strives to meet its aggressive LCFS targets."

VESTA™ 5100's commercial roll out will begin sometime in Q3 2018. In the meantime, VESTA™ 5000 will continue to be supplied to the marketplace.
